The Lake County Registrar of Voters Office wishes to inform residents that, for the November 3, 2026, General Election, **all registered voters will be issued a vote-by-mail ballot**. Initial ballot mailing begins **October 5, 2026**, with supplemental mailings to follow.

Return your ballot



By Mail – No postage is necessary. Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received within 7 days after the election to be counted. It is recommended that you mail your ballot early and request a manual postmark from a postal employee at the service counter of your local U.S. Post Office.



In-Person – Drop off your ballot at the Lake County Registrar of Voters office or at any Elections office, polling place, vote center, or official drop box within the State of California by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
